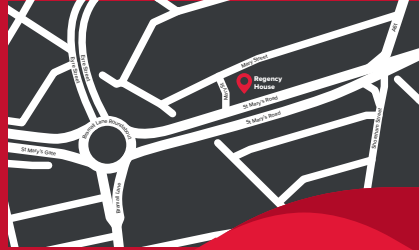

Dear Resident,

Mears Group has been responsible for delivering the Asylum Accommodation and Support Contract (AASC) across the North East, Yorkshire and Humber (NEYH) region since September 2019.

Our core values are founded on the delivery of exceptional quality, value, supporting our communities and above all keeping our promises.

As part of the AASC contract, Mears is required to provide Initial Accommodation (IA) to asylum seekers (Service Users). IA is hostel-type accommodation which Service Users typically occupy for a 4-6 week period during which their claim for Section 95 asylum support is assessed by the Home Office.

The principal IA facility for the NEYH region is Urban House in Wakefield, where demand has consistently exceeded capacity. This has resulted in the need to accommodate Service Users in hotel settings across the NEYH region.

Subject to planning, the proposals for Regency House to become overflow IA will hopefully eliminate the need to use hotel settings, and thereby enhance the safety, security and wellbeing of our Service Users.
